**Snead State scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis. Only complete applications will be reviewed. Please mark all scholarships that you wish to apply for. All applicants must include a 1) resume, 2) current transcript, and 3) one page essay outlining your educational and professional goals along with this application. A completed application for admission must be on file with the College before the scholarship can be awarded.**

**Presidential Honors Scholarship** applicants must be entering freshmen with a minimum 23 ACT **and** 3.75 core GPA. Each scholarship award equals full tuition and fees for up to 82 credit hours and includes a two-day leadership retreat and service learning experiences.

**Academic Achievement Scholarship** applicants must be entering freshmen with a minimum 3.5 core GPA. The student must also be eligible to enroll in college level math and English courses as evidenced by their ACT scores on the math and English sections of the ACT. A score of **20 in English** and a **21 in math** is required to meet this guideline. Each scholarship award equals full tuition and fees for up to 82 credit hours to be used over the course of two years.

**Leadership Scholarship** applicants must be entering freshmen with a 3.0 GPA and a resume that reflects a demonstrated capacity for leadership and/or on-campus involvement. Each scholarship award equals full tuition and fees for up to 82 credit hours to be used over the course of two years. Recipients will be required to perform service for the College.

**Service Scholarship** applicants must be entering freshmen. Each scholarship award equals full tuition and fees for up to 82 credit hours to be used over the course of two years. The student's resume and essay should demonstrate past community service experiences. Recipients will be required to perform service for the College.

**General Scholarship** applicants must demonstrate a financial need by completing the FAFSA. Each scholarship award is equal to full tuition and fees for up to 41 credit hours to be used over the course of one year. Applicants may reapply for this scholarship by completing a new FAFSA and scholarship application each year.

**Endowment Scholarship** awards vary by amount.

**Performing Arts Scholarships** are awarded based on the audition process. Please contact the Music Department at (256) 840-4145 for College Street Singers, Piano, Voice, and Guitar or 840-4148 for Jazz Band information. A scholarship application must be on file in the financial aid office for students planning to audition for these awards. Award amounts vary. Audition dates are set for March 11-13.

**Art Scholarships** are awarded on the basis of demonstrated artistic talent. A portfolio containing at least five works (charcoal, pencil, watercolor, chalk, pastel, etc.) must be submitted to the Fine Arts Department, and a completed scholarship application must be on file in the financial aid office. For additional information, call (256) 840-4145. Award amounts vary.

**Career/Technical Scholarships** are available for technology degrees offered on campus. Awards are based on technical interest and achievements. Awards are degree-specific and require the student to stay within the major to continue to use the funds. Award amounts vary.

**GED Scholarships** are available for students who recently (02/01/09 thru 01/31/10) completed their GED at Snead State. Awards are based on the overall score, an essay describing educational goals, and a resume.

**ATHLETIC (Women's Basketball, Men's Basketball, Men's Baseball, Women's Fast Pitch Softball, Women's Volleyball, Women's Tennis, Cheerleading, Dance Team)**

Athletic Scholarships are awarded on the basis of athletic talent and performance in each sport. Each scholarship award is full tuition and fees (up to 32 hours per year) and book loan for two semesters. Applicants must contact the coach of each sport as follows:
