Snead State scholarships are available to assist students in furthering their education and earning degrees from the College. In addition, all students requesting consideration for a scholarship must have a current FAFSA on file in the Financial Aid Office.

A complete scholarship application packet consists of the following:*

1. Scholarship application (this document)
2. Unofficial transcripts that include all college work completed
3. Academic plan (template is attached) that lists the courses you have remaining to complete your degree at Snead State Community College (use Degree Works and/or advisor for assistance)
4. One-page description of your goals and how a scholarship would allow you to complete your degree

**Mail or deliver the complete application packet with all documents to the financial aid office: Snead State Community College, ATTN: Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 734, Boaz, AL, 35957. In order to be considered in the first round of scholarship offers, a completed packet must be received in the financial aid office prior to the priority deadline.
