

HOW TO USE DEGREE WORKS

What is DegreeWorks?

DegreeWorks is a web-based tool for students to monitor their academic progress toward degree completion. It may be used for course planning & registration guidance.

Can I see how many classes I have left to fulfill my requirements?

Yes. DegreeWorks is laid out in block format displaying degree and major requirements information. Look for unchecked boxes to identify requirements that you still need to complete.

What is the 'What If' feature?

The 'What If' feature allows you to hypothetically change your major and will show you how your completed, current, and planned coursework meet the requirements of a hypothetical major. Students wishing to officially change his/her major should speak with an academic advisor and complete a 'Change of Major' form in the Student Services Office.

Steps to Use DegreeWorks:

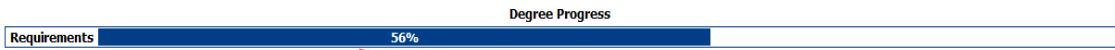
Login to *mySnead* using your S# and PIN. (<http://go.snead.edu>)
